Because of problems with private “scrapers” picking up select items like appliances and scrap metal, **MRC will not pick up items curbside. The electronics portion of the clean up will mostly be a drop off event.** MRC Representatives will be there to unload the items from your vehicle.

If you can *either volunteer or you need assistance* with any of your items due to being physically unable, call City Hall at 636-391-0600 *before* Saturday, October 7<sup>th</sup>. We will make every effort to accommodate the disposal of your items.

**Note:** TVs up to 26", \$30 ea; TVs 27" and larger, \$50 ea.; Console/Rear Projection TVs, \$50 ea.; CRT monitors, \$5. There will be a **\$5 charge to certify destruction** of a hard drive or cell phone. **Will not** be destroyed on site. A certificate will be mailed to the owner.

**Any Freon containing devices, \$10 ea., Lawn and Garden must have oil & gas removed.**

**NOT ACCEPTED:** Alkaline Batteries, CD’s/DVDs, VHS Tapes, Fluorescent Tubes, Light Bulbs, Smoke Detectors.
